

Did I Pay My Bill?

Water is an essential commodity. Although relatively inexpensive, it can become quite costly when our water bills don't get paid on time, and it becomes more than an inconvenience when our water is turned off for non-payment.

A late fee of \$2.92, a returned check charge of \$20.00 and a re-connection fee of \$30.00 (\$65.00 if after hours) can make a \$29.25 water bill cost almost \$83.00. That same \$83.00 would pay the \$29.25 water bill for almost three months!

A great way to pay your water bill is by Automatic Bank Draft.

Around the 10th of each month you will receive a statement of your water services which reads, "*Bank Draft, Do Not Remit*". At that time you should note the amount of your water bill in your checkbook. *Your checking account will be drafted on the 1st of the following month.* This process gives you approximately 2 ½ weeks to review your bill, and ensure that there are adequate funds in your account to cover the bank draft.
